No. 47279-47280/2018 [EDN-Reg.P]

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the application dated 28.02.2019 of Chairman, G. Anuradha Education Trust, Bangalore for establishment of a New Homeopathic Medical College in the name of "Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital" with 60 seats in BHMS Course under 12 A of HCC Act, 1973, for the academic session 2019-20 and in continuation of the Central Council of Homoeopathy's letter No. 15-5/2018- CCH(13) /3015 dated 25.07.2019, wherein Letter of Intent was issued.

2. The Executive Committee to the Board of Governor considered the inspection report dated 11.07.2019 at the stage of LoP and recommended vide letter No. 15-12019-CCH/3756 dated 23.07.2019 as under:

*"The executive Committee decided to recommend for issuance of Letter of permission (LOP) for starting of new BHMS Course with intake capacity of 60 seats from the session 2019-20 subject to the condition that the college would appoint full strength of Guest Faculty at the time of commencement of new session."*

3. After careful consideration of your proposal in terms of the provision of the HCC Act 1973, relevant regulations, inspection report and recommendation of the CCH; permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the Chairman, G. Anuradha Education Trust, Bangalore for establishment of a New Homeopathic Medical College in the name of "Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital" with 60 seats in BHMS Course under 12 A of HCC Act, 1973, for the academic session 2019-20 subject to the condition that the college would appoint full strength of Guest Faculty at the time of commencement of new session.

3. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teaching faculty, non-teaching staff, hospital staff and other requirements as per the provision of HCC (MSR), 2013 Regulations are in position before the admission of the first batch of students with 100 seats, under intimation to the Central Government and CCH.

4. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for 2<sup>nd</sup> BHMS course well in time as per the CCH norms which will be verified and reported by the CCH at least three months before the start of next professional session and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.
5. It is further informed that 15% of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. The permission to the college will stand withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.
7. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from date of issue of this permission letter explaining the details of providing EPI and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
8. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P.No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.
9. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2019 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2020-21 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
10. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.



**ORDER**

WHEREAS, as per the provision of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973 all Homoeopathy Medical Colleges shall seek permission of the Central Government within 01 year from the date of promulgation of HCC (Amendment) Ordinance, 2018.

2. WHEREAS, as per the policy of Ministry of Ayush, CCH examined the Part-1 of the proforma of inspection of college submitted by the **Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Srigandrakaval, Sringandanagar, B.B.M.P. Ward No.70, Near B.W.S.S.B. Water Tank & Hegganahalli Cross, Vishwaneedam Post, Bangalore-560091** and recommended for not allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 due to substantial shortage in teaching faculties, hospital staffs and other shortfalls.

The reasons for recommendation for not granting permission to the Applicant College and Hospital are as under:-

1. College is having only 13 eligible teachers against 18. College has provided a list of 24 teachers but 11 teachers considered ineligible due to discrepancies in their documents. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:
  - a. Dr. Kavitha C., MD (Hom), Prof. Anatomy: joined on 17.06.2019, Previous experience in HMM (2011-2018), Exp. of Lect. Anatomy is only 01 year (2001-02), No other experience provided. Further, Affidavit of Reader in Dept of Anatomy is not submitted. Hence, there is deficiency of 1 higher faculty in Dept of Anatomy.
  - b. Dr. Arjun Singh M S, MD (Hom), Reader, Physiology: joined on 27.11.2019, Experience as Lecturer, Physiology is 16 months (2016-2018), Guest Reader in BBHMC, Bengaluru (2018-19).
  - c. Dr. Archana Panwar, MD (Hom), Lecturer, HMM: joined on 23.09.2019, Joining & Appointment letter is not signed either by applicant or by Principal. Further, Affidavit of Reader in Dept of HMM is not submitted. There is deficiency of 1 lower faculty in Dept of HMM.
  - d. Dr. Anuradha B S, MD (Hom), Lecturer, OBG: joined on 02.11.2019, Joining & Appointment letter is not signed either by applicant or by Principal; Sign in



documents for teacher's code not matches with affidavit. Further, 1 higher faculty is also deficient in Dept of OBG.

- e. No documents or affidavit provided for Lecturer (Pathology) and Reader (Organon, Pharmacy, Pathology, and Surgery)."
2. No Part Time teachers of Modern Medicine available against requirement of 09.
3. Acquittance roll of 16 Hospital staff not available.
4. Details of Librarian & Library Assistant not provided in Attendance & Acquittance roll of Non-teaching staff thus considered not available.
5. In Teaching department:
  - a. Cadaver not available in department of Anatomy.
  - b. Alcohol/Spirit license/Permission applied in department of Pharmacy.
6. Details of IPD/OPD data, Students details & Non-teaching staff not available on college website: [www.anuradhahomeopathic.edu.in](http://www.anuradhahomeopathic.edu.in).
7. The college has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
8. Supportive documents of salary through bank is not provided and only 40% salary paid for the month of April, May 2020 & 25% for June 2020.

3. WHEREAS, the Central Government while examining the inspection report and recommendation of Board of Governors of CCH in terms of the provisions of HCC Act 1973 and the regulations made thereunder, has observed that the college is not fulfilling the following basic eligibility conditions: -

1. College is having only 13 eligible teachers against 18. College has provided a list of 24 teachers but 11 teachers considered ineligible due to discrepancies in their documents. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:
  - a. Dr. Kavitha C., MD (Hom), Prof. Anatomy is ineligible.
  - b. Dr. Arjun Singh M S, MD (Hom), Reader, Physiology has left the college and the college had appointed Dr. M. Prakash Kumar, MD (Hom.) in the Department of Physiology since 05.11.2020, is also ineligible.
  - c. Dr. M. Prakash Kumar, MD (Hom.) is not eligible as he has no previous experience as Lecturer and Reader in concerned subject i.e. Physiology.
- d. 1 higher faculty is deficient in Dept of OBG.
- e. The College had not submitted any documents or affidavit for Lecturer (Pathology) and Reader (Organon, Pharmacy, Pathology, and Surgery)."
2.
  - a. Cadaver not available in department of Anatomy.
  - b. Alcohol /Spirit license/ Permission not available in department of Pharmacy.

3. The details of Non-teaching staff are not available on college website.

4. Whereas, in view of the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned in Para 3 above, the college was given an opportunity of hearing through Video-conferencing as a principle of natural justice of being heard vide Ministry's Hearing Notice of even no. dated 11.11.2020 to appear before the designated Hearing Committee in the Ministry of AYUSH to present their case for substantiating with respect to above

mentioned short comings. The hearing was conducted on 24.11.2020 via video conferencing. The representative of the college submitted written submissions before the Hearing Committee.

5. The observation made by Hearing Committee is as under -

1. College is having only 13 eligible teachers against 18. College has provided a list of 24 teachers but 11 teachers considered ineligible due to discrepancies in their documents. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:

a. Dr. Kavitha C., MD (Hom), Prof. Anatomy: joined on 17.06.2019, Previous experience in HMM (2011-2018), Exp. of Lect. Anatomy is only 01 year (2001-02), No other experience provided. Further, Affidavit of Reader in Dept of Anatomy is not submitted. Hence, there is deficiency of 1 higher faculty in Dept of Anatomy.

On examining the documents it has been observed that Dr. Kavitha C., MD (Hom) had one year experience of Lect. Anatomy for the year 2001-02 at BBHMC & H, Bangalore college(p. 16/c), one year one month experience of Lect. Anatomy for the period 02.04.2005 to 31.05.2006 in AAHMC & H, Bijapur college (p. 17/c); 06 months of experience of Assistant Prof. Anatomy for the period 01.12.2018 to 14.06.2019 at BBHMC & H, Bangalore college and one year five months experience of Lect. Anatomy for the period 17.06.2019 to 10.11.2019 at Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Srigandrakaval, Sringandanagar. She is having a total of 04 years of experience as Lect. Anatomy. The copy of her promotion to associate prof. is at (p. 13/c). She had experience of Lecturer and reader of Dept. of Materia medica for the period of 02.11.2011 to 26.10.2018 at BBHMC & H, Bangalore College (p. 16/c). The copy of the affidavit dated 21.11.2020 is submitted at p. 9-11/c.

**Remarks of Ministry:** As per HCC MSR 1983, three year teaching experience of as Demonstrator is required. Dr. Kavitha C did not have teaching experience as Demonstrator at the time of her first appointment as lecturer in Anatomy in 2001, so her experience as lecturer in 2001 is not considered. Hence, Dr. Kavitha C., MD (Hom) is ineligible.

b. Dr. Arjun Singh M S, MD (Hom), Reader, Physiology: joined on 27.11.2019, Experience as Lecturer, Physiology is 16 months (2016-2018), Guest Reader in BBHMC, Bengaluru (2018-19).

On examining the documents it has been observed that Dr. Arjun Singh M S, MD (Hom), Reader, Physiology has left the college; however no documents have been submitted by the college to substantiate his availability and relieving from the college. Further the college had appointed Dr. M. Prakash Kumar, MD (Hom.) in the Department of Physiology since 05.11.2020 (p. 26-



38/c). The copy of the affidavit dated 17.11.2020 is submitted at p. 23-25/c.

**Remarks of Ministry:** Dr. M. Prakash Kumar, MD (Hom.) is not eligible as he has no previous experience as Lecturer and Reader in concerned subject i.e. Physiology.

- c. Dr. Archana Panwar, MD (Hom), Lecturer, HMM: joined on 23.09.2019, Joining & Appointment letter is not signed either by applicant or by Principal. Further, Affidavit of Reader in Dept of HMM is not submitted. There is deficiency of 1 lower faculty in Dept of HMM.

**Observations:** The college representatives submitted that they had one higher faculty Dr. A.L.Patil (Professor) and one lower faculty Dr. Ramya (Assistant Professor) in the Dept of HMM. They had submitted affidavit and documents for Dr. A.L.Patil and Dr. Ramya. However no documents have been submitted for Dr. Archana Panwar (p.39-57/c).

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing Committee they had one higher faculty Dr. A.L.Patil (Professor) and one lower faculty Dr. Ramya (Assistant Professor) in the Dept of HMM. They had submitted affidavit and documents for Dr. A.L.Patil and Dr. Ramya.

- d. Dr. Anuradha B S, MD (Hom), Lecturer, OBG: joined on 02.11.2019, Joining & Appointment letter is not signed either by applicant or by Principal; Sign in documents for teacher's code not matches with affidavit. Further, 1 higher faculty is also deficient in Dept of OBG.

**Observations:** The college representatives submitted a letter by Dr. Anuradha B S, MD (Hom) declaring that the sign in documents for teacher's code and affidavit is signed by her only. The college had submitted the copy of her PU marks and pan card for verification. (p.58-60/c). The college had submitted that absence of signatures on joining & Appointment letter either by applicant or by Principal is clerical error. They had also submitted duly signed joining, appointment letter by her and documents for educational certificates (p. 68-73). They had submitted that Dr. Anuradha B S is an additional junior faculty in the department and Dr. Priyanka is also serving in the college as junior faculty. They had also submitted the joining, appointment letter and documents for educational certificates for Dr. Priyanka (p.61-67/c).

1 higher faculty is deficient in Dept of OBG.

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee lecturer is available in OBG But 01 higher faculty is deficient in Dept of OBG.

- e. No documents or affidavit provided for Lecturer (Pathology) and Reader

**Observations:** The College had not submitted any documents or affidavit for Lecturer (Pathology) and Reader (Organon, Pharmacy, Pathology, and Surgery)."

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee The College had not submitted any documents or affidavit for Lecturer (Pathology) and Reader (Organon, Pharmacy, Pathology, and Surgery).

**2. No Part Time teachers of Modern Medicine available against requirement of 09.**

**Observations:** The College had recently appointed 09 part time teachers of Modern Medicine dated 11.11.2020 in the college. They had submitted the joining, appointment letter and documents for educational certificates for these part time teachers of Modern Medicine (p.74-128/c).

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee the College had recently appointed 09 part time teachers of Modern Medicine dated 11.11.2020 in the college.

**3. Acquittance roll of 16 Hospital staff not available.**

**Observations:** The College had submitted that in the Acquittance roll of the hospital staff the details of 22 were mentioned whereas the details of remaining 22 hospital staff the details of 9 modern medicine staff were mentioned in separate register and 13 were written in hospital administrative acquittance roll. They had submitted a copy of the Acquittance roll of the 22 hospital staff for the month of December 2019, January 2020 and February 2020 only. The details of Librarian & Library Assistant have also mentioned here. The details for other hospital staff have not provided by the college. (P.129-134/c).

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee Acquittance roll for the 22 hospital staff is available.

**4. Details of Librarian & Library Assistant not provided in Attendance & Acquittance roll of Non-teaching staff thus considered not available.**

**Observations:** The College had submitted that absence of details of Librarian & Library Assistant not provided in Attendance & Acquittance roll of Non-teaching staff is clerical error and were written in the next page of the same attendance register and the Acquittance roll for these have been clubbed with the hospital staff. (p. 135-139/c).

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee Details of Librarian & Library Assistant in the Attendance & Acquittance roll have been submitted.



**5. In Teaching department:****a. Cadaver not available in department of Anatomy.**

**Observations:** The College had submitted that for cadaver they had submitted necessary documents to the Government of Karnataka and has also requested the neighboring principal of AYUSH college for availing the services of their anatomy lab and on 21.11.2019 the principal of neighboring college has agreed for the same. (p.140-146/c).

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee Cadaver is not available in department of Anatomy.

**b. Alcohol/Spirit license/Permission applied in department of Pharmacy.**

**Observations:** The College had submitted that they had submitted necessary documents to the Government of Karnataka for permission to store alcohol; however the state Government is not permitted to grant permission and they had obtained alternatively alcohol which is permissible in the law. (p.147-149/c).

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee Alcohol/Spirit license/Permission is not available in department of Pharmacy.

**6. Details of IPD/OPD data, Students details & Non-teaching staff not available on college website: [www.anuradhahomoeopathic.edu.in](http://www.anuradhahomoeopathic.edu.in).**

**Observations:** It is observed that the details of IPD/OPD data and Students details for the year 2019 are available on college website. The details of Non-teaching staff are not available on college website. They had submitted the documents for details of IPD/OPD data, and Students details for the year 2019 (p. 150-152/c).

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee the details of Non-teaching staff are not available on college website.

**7. The college has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.**

**Observations:** The College had submitted that they had already taken necessary steps for implementation of Employee's provident funds & ESI. (a) and had be allotted code number 4900043860001303 to eligible employees. (p.155-16/c).

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee The College is complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.



8. Supportive documents of salary through bank is not provided and only 40% salary paid for the month of April, May 2020 & 25% for June 2020.

**Observations:** The College had submitted that due to COVID-19 pandemic crisis the Government had not paid CET sponsored amount and due to financial crisis they had salaries at the rate of 40% for the month of April, May 2020 & 25% for June 2020. This payment is pending payment of balance amount and after revival of financial conditions and receipt of Government CET amount (p. 157-205/c)

**Remarks of Ministry:** As observed by Hearing committee that only 40% salary paid for the month of April, May 2020 & 25% paid for June 2020 due to financial crisis due to COVID-19 pandemic. Supportive documents of salary through bank have been provided.

**Overall observations of the hearing committee:**

1. College is having only 13 eligible teachers against 18. College has provided a list of 24 teachers but 11 teachers considered ineligible due to discrepancies in their documents. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:
  - f. Dr. Kavitha C., MD (Hom), Prof. Anatomy is having a total of 04 years of experience as Lect. Anatomy.
  - g. Dr. Arjun Singh M S, MD (Hom), Reader, Physiology has left the college and the college had appointed Dr. M. Prakash Kumar, MD (Hom.) in the Department of Physiology since 05.11.2020.
  - h. No documents and affidavit have been submitted for Dr. Archana Panwar. However, the college had informed that one lower faculty Dr. Ramya (Assistant Professor) is available in the Dept of HMM.
  - i. The college representatives submitted a letter by Dr. Anuradha B S, MD (Hom) declaring that the sign in documents for teacher's code and affidavit is signed by her only. The college had submitted the copy of her PU marks and pan card for verification. The college had submitted that absence of signatures on joining & Appointment letter either by applicant or by Principal is clerical error.

1 higher faculty is deficient in Dept of OBG.
2. The College had not submitted any documents or affidavit for Lecturer (Pathology) and Reader (Organon, Pharmacy, Pathology, and Surgery)."
3. The College had recently appointed 09 part time teachers of Modern Medicine dated 11.11.2020 in the college.
4. Acquittance roll for the 22 hospital staff only is available.
5. Details of Librarian & Library Assistant in the Attendance & Acquittance roll have been submitted.
6. a. Cadaver not available in department of Anatomy.  
b. Alcohol/Spirit license/Permission have been applied in department of Pharmacy.
7. The details of IPD/OPD data, and Students details for the year 2019 is available on college website. The details of Non-teaching staff are not available on college website.
8. The college is complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

9. The college is agreed that only 40% salary paid for the month of April, May 2020 & 25% for June 2020 have been paid due to financial crisis due to COVID-19 pandemic. Supportive documents of salary through bank have been provided.

6. Whereas, in view of the above observations of the Hearing Committee based on submission made by the college during hearing as in Para 5 above and the recommendations of the CCH referred in Para 2 above, it can be understood that as per the norms, the college does not fulfill the eligibility conditions for granting permission for taking admission in 1-BHMS course with 60 seats for the academic year 2020-21 as college is not having requisite full time teaching faculties and other deficiencies at the time of submission of Part-1 of Proforma of inspection of college.

7. Now, therefore, in view of the shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned in Para 6 above, which violate the provisions of the HCC Act and the relevant regulations and are of such a serious and fundamental in nature that they adversely affect the ability of the College to provide quality medical education in terms of the provisions of the HCC Act and the relevant regulations **Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Srigandrakaval, Srirangandanagar, B.B.M.P. Ward No.70, Near B.W.S.S.B. Water Tank & Hegganahalli Cross, Vishwaneedam Post, Bangalore-560091, is hereby denied permission for taking admission in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 UG seats for the academic session 2020-21.**

8. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

9. Further, the College shall submit comply with the procedure to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.

10. Further, it is informed that the college is being provided a period up to 31.12.2020 to fulfill the shortcomings observed during this year as mentioned at Para 5 above along with the following requirements, so that the CCH may carry out inspection of the college for consideration of matter for grant of permission for taking admissions in BHMS course from the academic year 2021-22:

a. all the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching &

- training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013" by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 and

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act".

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-I proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take certain time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course. The deficiencies observed are as below:

**A. Hospital staff:**

- Surgeon (General Surgery) is not available as required.
- Auxiliary staff - Lab Attendant not available.
- Dr. Thej MJ is available as Pathologist and Dietician but can be considered in one post only.

**B. Teaching Faculty:**

- The College has provided list of 35 full time teachers out of which 31 are eligible. Discrepancies in engagement of teachers are as below:
  - Dr. Narayan C Deshpande, Professor - Date of birth is 13.2.56. Age exceeding 65 years so not eligible in the Department of Organon.
  - Affidavit of following teachers not provided: Reader (Community Medicine and Forensic Medicine and Toxicology), Professor (Practice of Medicine).



- a) The College has provided list of 08 guest faculty out of which 05 are eligible. Previous full time teaching experience of following guest faculties not provided: Reader (Pathology Surgery and Obstetrics/Gynecology).
- ii. The College has provided a list of 05 part time teachers of Modern Medicine but 03 are eligible as documents of only 03 consultants provided.
- C. Library: Cataloguing system not available.
- D. Miscellaneous:
- Biometric Attendance - Document not provided.
  - EPF/PF/ESI deductions of teachers, non-teaching staff & hospital staff - deducted of only 5 staffs (Challan of only February 2021 provided for 05 members).
- E. Website: <http://www.anuradhaomoeopathic.edu.in> - Student's data, Non-teaching staffs; and OPD/IPD data of 2021 is not updated as checked on 28/09/2021.

3. Whereas, in view of the above deficiencies observed in Para 2, the college was given an opportunity of hearing through Video-conferencing as a principle of natural justice of being heard vide Hearing Notice letter of even no. 4-3/2021/NCH (MA&BH)(Visitation matter)/2751 dated 09.11.2021 to appear before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case for substantiating with respect to above mentioned short comings. The hearing was conducted on 12.11.2021 at 3:30 p.m. The Principal of the college submitted written submissions before the Hearing Committee.

4. WHEREAS, the deficiencies communicated to the college, submission made by the college at the time of Hearing and observation of the Hearing Committee has been examined vis-à-vis with the provisions of HCC, Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made there under and following deficiencies are found to be existing:

WHEREAS, in view of the observations of the hearing committee based on submission made by the college during hearing and the Part I submitted by the college, referred in Para 2 above, it can be understood that as per the notified and approved criteria for 2021-22 session, the college does not fulfill the eligibility conditions for granting permission for taking admission in BHMS course with 60 seats for the academic year 2021-22.

6. NOW, Therefore, in view of the shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned above, which violate the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, which adversely affect the ability of the College to provide quality medical education, Denial of permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Srigandrakaval, Sringandanagar, B.B.M.P. Ward No.70, Near B.W.S.S.B. Water Tank & Hegganahalli Cross, Vishwaneedam Post, Bangalore-560091 for continuing admissions for BHMS with 60 seats for the academic session 2021-22.

7. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

8. As per section 24 (3) of NCH Act 2020, The College aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that a communication dated 15.03.2021 is given by the Central Council of Homeopathy (CCH) stating that although the Committee is of the opinion that the petitioner-Institution does not have the eligibility for grant of permission for 60 Undergraduate seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2020-2021, however, considering the COVID-19 pandemic situation, the Ministry has relaxed the criteria for granting permission with reduced seats of 30 Undergraduate seats and if the petitioner-Institution is willing to the said conditions, it would be permitted to admit 30 students. The learned Counsel submits that the respondent-authorities are coercing the petitioner to accept the reduced intake. Therefore, the learned Counsel submits that while the petitioner may be permitted to accept 30 Undergraduate seats, however, the petitioner should be permitted to agitate the grounds raised in this writ petition without foreclosing the matter on the ground that the petitioner has accepted the conditions imposed by the respondent-authorities. Accordingly, the petitioner-Institution is permitted to admit 30 Undergraduate students in BHMS course as stated in the communication dated 15.03.2021. However, the matter will not be closed on the ground that the petitioner has accepted the conditions imposed by the respondent-authorities.

- Educational CD: Films, Slides not available.

c) **Biochemistry**

1. Balance, Chemical/ordinary 01 against the requirement of 02.

d) **Homoeopathic Pharmacy**

- Thin layer chromatography apparatus not available.



3. **Miscellaneous:-**

- Biometric attendance not available.
- Acquittance is provided but without stamp.
- Form-16 provided but not from traces portal.


After considering the provisions of NCH Act,2020 and its relevant regulations **Conditional Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College, Srigandakaval, Srigandanagar, Near Hegganahalli Cross, B.B.M.P. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.


